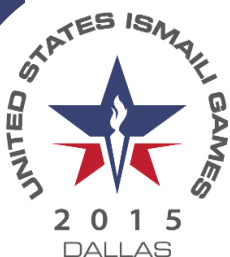


PLAYOFF SEEDING AND TIEBREAKERS

BASKETBALL TIEBREAKER

1. Teams will be ranked based on Overall Winning Percentage (OWP)
 - Calculation: $\text{Total Preliminary Round Games Won} / \text{Total Preliminary Round Games Played}$
2. If multiple teams are tied with the same OWP then:
 - If 2 teams are tied:
 - Head to head winner from Preliminary Round will get the higher seed
 - If the 2 teams did not face each other in the Preliminary Round, then this tiebreaker does not apply and move to the next tiebreaker
3. If teams are still tied, then the team with the highest average point differential will get the higher seed
 - Calculation: $(\text{Total Points Scored} - \text{Total Points Allowed}) / (\text{Total Preliminary Games Played})$
4. If teams are still tied, then the team with the most points scored PER GAME will get the higher seed
 - Calculation: $(\text{Total Points Scored}) / (\text{Total Preliminary Games Played})$
5. If teams are still tied, then the team with the least points allowed PER GAME will get the higher seed
 - Calculation: $(\text{Total Points Allowed}) / (\text{Total Preliminary Games Played})$
6. If the teams are still tied, then a random draw (i.e. coin toss or electronic formula) will determine the higher seed

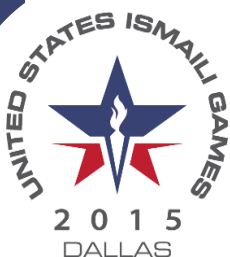


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FLAG FOOTBALL TIEBREAKER

1. Teams will be ranked based on Overall Winning Percentage (OWP)
 - Calculation: $\text{Total Preliminary Matches Won} / \text{Total Preliminary Round Games Played}$
2. If multiple teams are tied with the same OWP then:
 - If 2 teams are tied:
 - Head to head winner from Preliminary Round will get the higher seed
 - If the 2 teams did not face each other in the Preliminary Round, then this tiebreaker does not apply and move to the next tiebreaker
3. If teams are still tied, then the team with the highest average point differential will get the higher seed
 - Calculation: $(\text{Total Points Scored} - \text{Total Points Allowed}) / (\text{Total Preliminary Games Played})$
4. If teams are still tied, then the team with the most points scored PER GAME will get the higher seed
 - Calculation: $(\text{Total Points Scored}) / (\text{Total Preliminary Games Played})$
5. If teams are still tied, then the team with the least points allowed PER GAME will get the higher seed
 - Calculation: $(\text{Total Points Allowed}) / (\text{Total Preliminary Games Played})$
6. If the teams are still tied, then a random draw (i.e. coin toss or electronic formula) will determine the higher seed



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SOCCKER TIEBREAKER

1. The teams with the highest Point Total Based on Scoring System will get the higher seeds
 - 3 points per win or forfeit win
 - 1 point for a tie, no result or match not played
 - 0 points for loss, forfeit or disqualification
2. If multiple teams are tied with the same OWP then:
 - If 2 teams are tied:
 - Head to head winner from Preliminary Round will get the higher seed
 - If the 2 teams did not face each other in the Preliminary Round, then this tiebreaker does not apply and move to the next tiebreaker
3. If teams are still tied, then the team with the highest average goal differential will get the higher seed
 - Calculation: $(\text{Total Goals Scored} - \text{Total Goals Allowed}) / (\text{Total Preliminary Games Played})$
4. If teams are still tied, then the team with the most goals scored PER GAME will get the higher seed
 - Calculation: $(\text{Total Goals Scored}) / (\text{Total Preliminary Games Played})$
5. If teams are still tied, then the team with the least goals allowed PER GAME will get the higher seed
 - Calculation: $(\text{Total Goals Allowed}) / (\text{Total Preliminary Games Played})$
6. If the teams are still tied, then a random draw (i.e. coin toss or electronic formula) will determine the higher seed

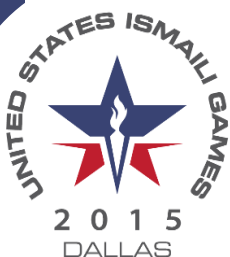


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SOFTBALL TIEBREAKER

1. Teams will be ranked based on Overall Winning Percentage (OWP)
 - Calculation: $\text{Total Preliminary Matches Won} / \text{Total Preliminary Round Games Played}$
2. If multiple teams are tied with the same OWP then:
 - If 2 teams are tied:
 - Head to head winner from Preliminary Round will get the higher seed
 - If the 2 teams did not face each other in the Preliminary Round, then this tiebreaker does not apply and move to the next tiebreaker
3. If teams are still tied, then the team with the highest average run differential will get the higher seed
 - Calculation: $(\text{Total Runs Scored} - \text{Total Runs Allowed}) / (\text{Total Preliminary Games Played})$
4. If teams are still tied, then the team with the most runs scored PER GAME will get the higher seed
 - Calculation: $(\text{Total Runs Scored}) / (\text{Total Preliminary Games Played})$
5. If teams are still tied, then the team with the least runs allowed PER GAME will get the higher seed
 - Calculation: $(\text{Total Runs Allowed}) / (\text{Total Preliminary Games Played})$
6. If the teams are still tied, then a random draw (i.e. coin toss or electronic formula) will determine the higher seed

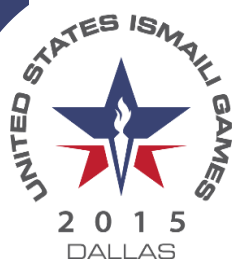


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INTERNATIONAL VOLLEYBALL TIEBREAKER

1. Teams will be ranked based on Overall Winning Percentage (OWP)
 - Calculation: Total Preliminary Matches Won / Total Preliminary Round Matches Played
2. If multiple teams are tied with the same OWP then:
 - If 2 teams are tied:
 - Head to head winner from Preliminary Round will get the higher seed
 - If the 2 teams did not face each other in the Preliminary Round, then this tiebreaker does not apply and move next tiebreaker
3. If teams are still tied, then the team with the most average sets won PER MATCH will get the higher seed
 - Calculation: (Total Preliminary Sets Won)/(Total Preliminary Matches Played)
 - Example: Match 1: 2-1; Match 2: 1-2; Match 3: 2-1; Total Preliminary Sets Lost = 5, Total Preliminary Matches Played = 3;
 - Average Sets won PER MATCH = 1.667.
4. If teams are still tied, then the team with the lowest average sets lost PER MATCH will get the higher seed
 - Calculation: (Total Preliminary Sets Lost)/(Total Preliminary Matches Played)
 - Example: Match 1: 2-1; Match 2: 1-2; Match 3: 2-1; Total Preliminary Sets Lost = 4; Total Preliminary Matches Played = 3;
 - Average Sets Lost PER MATCH = 1.333.
5. If teams are still tied, then the team with the most points scored PER MATCH will get the higher seed. The max points that will be used for the purposes of this calculation will be 25 or 23 (for sets 1 and 2) and 15 or 13 (for set 3).
 - Calculation: (Total Points Scored in all Matches)/(Total Preliminary Matches Played)
 - Example: Match 1: 27-25, 25-10; Match 2: 25-20, 27-29, 15-12; Match 3: 25-15, 25-16; Total points scored: (25+25+25+23+15+25+25) = 163; Total Matches Played = 3;
 - Points scored per match = 54.333
6. If teams are still tied, then the team with the least points allowed PER MATCH will get the higher seed. The max points that will be used for the purposes of this calculation will be 25 or 23 (for set 1 and 2) and 15 or 13 (for set 3).
 - Calculation: (Total Points Allowed)/(Total Preliminary Matches Played)
 - Example: Match 1: 27-25, 25-10; Match 2: 25-20, 27-29, 15-12; Match 3: 25-15, 25-16; Total points allowed: (23+10+20+25+12+15+16) = 114; Total Matches Played = 3;



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- Points allowed per match = 40.333
7. If the teams are still tied, then a random draw (i.e. coin toss or electronic formula) will determine the higher seed

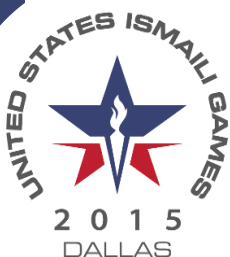


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TRADITIONAL VOLLEYBALL TIEBREAKER

1. Teams will be ranked based on number of points received
 - For each preliminary round win, a team will receive 2 points
 - For each preliminary round tie, a team will receive 1 point
 - For each preliminary round loss, a team will receive 0 points
 - After all preliminary matches have been played, the teams will be ranked based on most points accumulated during the preliminary round
2. If multiple teams are tied with the same number of points then:
 - If 2 teams are tied:
 - Head to head winner from Preliminary Round will get the higher seed
 - If the 2 teams did not face each other in the Preliminary Round, then this tiebreaker does not apply and move next tiebreaker
3. If teams are still tied, then the team with the highest average sets won PER MATCH will get the higher seed
 - Calculation: $(\text{Total Preliminary Sets Won})/(\text{Total Preliminary Matches Played})$
 - Example: Match 1: 2-1, Match 2: 1-2, Match 3: 2-1, Total Preliminary Sets Won = 5, Total Preliminary Matches Played = 3;
 - Average Sets Lost PER MATCH: 1.667.
4. If teams are still tied, then the team with the lowest average sets lost PER MATCH will get the higher seed
 - Calculation: $(\text{Total Preliminary Sets Lost})/(\text{Total Preliminary Matches Played})$
 - Example: Match 1: 2-1, Match 2: 1-2, Match 3: 2-1, Total Preliminary Sets Lost = 4, Total Preliminary Matches Played = 3;
 - Average Sets Lost PER MATCH: 1.333.
5. If teams are still tied, then the team with the most points scored PER MATCH will get the higher seed. The max points that will be used for the purposes of this calculation will be 21 (for the winner) or 19 (for loser)
 - Calculation: $(\text{Total Points Scored in all Matches})/(\text{Total Preliminary Matches Played})$
 - Example: Match 1: 27-25, 21-10, Match 2: 20-22, 27-29, Match 3: 21-15, 21-16; Total points scored: $(21+21+19+19+21+21) = 122$; Total Matches Played = 3;
 - Points scored per match = 40.667
6. If teams are still tied, then the team with the least points allowed PER MATCH will get the higher seed. The max points that will be used for the purposes of this calculation will be 25 or 23 (set 1), 25 or 23 (set 2) and 15 or 13 (set 3).
 - Calculation: $(\text{Total Points Allowed})/(\text{Total Preliminary Matches Played})$



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- Example: Match 1: 27-25, 21-10, Match 2: 20-22, 27-29, Match 3: 21-15, 21-16;
Total points allowed: $(19+10+21+21+15+16) = 102$; Total Matches Played = 3;
 - Points allowed per match = 34
7. If the teams are still tied, then a random draw (i.e. coin toss or electronic formula) will determine the higher seed



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HARDBALL CRICKET TIEBREAKER

1. The teams with the highest Point Total Based on Scoring System will get the higher seeds
 - 2 points per win or forfeit win
 - 1 point for a tie, no result or match not played
 - 0 points for loss, forfeit or disqualification
2. If multiple teams are tied with the same number of points then:
 - If 2 teams are tied:
 - Head to head winner from Preliminary Round will get the higher seed
 - If the 2 teams did not face each other in the Preliminary Round, then this tiebreaker does not apply and move next tiebreaker
3. If teams are still tied, then Net Run Rate will be used to break the tie
 - Net Run Rate = (Total runs scored / total balls faced) – (Total runs allowed / total balls bowled)
 - Example:
 - If Team A bats first and scores 120 runs in 20 overs, and Team B batting second scores 124 runs in 18 over and 2 balls, then Team B is the winner with 2 points and the per-ball run rate will be as follows:
 - Team A batting at 120 RUNS / 120 BALLS, which is equal to 1.00 run per ball, and bowling at 122 RUNS / 110 BALLS, which is equal to 1.11 runs per ball. For this match, the Net Run Rate for Team A will be $1.00 - 1.11 = -0.11$.
 - Team B batting at 122 RUNS / 110 BALLS, which is equal to 1.11 runs per ball and bowling at 120 RUNS / 120 BALLS, which is equal to 1.00 runs per ball. For this match, the Net Run Rate for Team B will be $1.11 - 1.00 = +0.11$.
4. If the teams are still tied, then a random draw (i.e. coin toss or electronic formula) will determine the higher seed

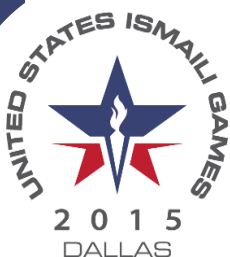


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TENNIS TIEBREAKER

1. Players/teams will be ranked based on Overall Winning Percentage (OWP)
 - Calculation: Total Preliminary Round Matches Won / Total Preliminary Round Matches Played
2. If multiple players/teams are tied with the same OWP then:
 - If 2 teams are tied:
 - Head to head winner from Preliminary Round will get the higher seed
 - If the 2 players/teams did not face each other in the Preliminary Round, move to the next tiebreaker
3. If teams are still tied, then the team with the highest average of sets won PER MATCH will get the higher seed
 - Calculation: (Total Preliminary Sets Won)/(Total Preliminary Matches Played)
 - Example: Match 1: 2-1, Match 2: 1-2, Match 3: 2-1, Total Preliminary Sets Won = 5, Total Preliminary Matches Played = 3;
 - Average Sets Won PER MATCH: 1.667.
4. If teams are still tied, then the team with the lowest average sets lost PER MATCH will get the higher seed
 - Calculation: (Total Preliminary Sets Lost)/(Total Preliminary Matches Played)
 - Example: Match 1: 2-1, Match 2: 1-2, Match 3: 2-1, Total Preliminary Sets Lost = 4, Total Preliminary Matches Played = 3;
 - Average Sets Lost PER MATCH: 1.333.
5. If teams are still tied, then the team with the most games won PER MATCH will get the higher seed. The max games that will be used for the purposes of this calculation will be 3 (for the winner) or 1 (for the loser)
 - Calculation: (Total Games Won in all Matches)/(Total Preliminary Matches Played)
 - Example:
 - Match 1: 3-0, 2-4, 3-1; Match 2: 4-2, 3-0; Match 3: 2-4, 0-3;
 - Total games won: $[(3,1,3);(3,3);(1,0)] = 14$;
 - Total Matches Played = 3;
 - Points scored per match = 4.667
6. If teams are still tied, then the team with the least games lost PER MATCH will get the higher seed. The max games that will be used for the purposes of this calculation will be 3 (for the winner) or 1 (for the loser)
 - Calculation: (Total Games Lost in all Matches)/(Total Preliminary Matches Played)
 - Example:
 - Match 1: 3-0, 2-4, 3-1; Match 2: 4-2, 3-0; Match 3: 2-4, 0-3;



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- Total points allowed: [(0,3,1);(1,0);(3,3)] = 11
 - Total Matches Played = 3;
 - Points allowed per match = 3.667
7. If the teams are still tied, then a random draw (i.e. coin toss or electronic formula) will determine the higher seed



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TABLE TENNIS TIEBREAKER

8. Players/teams will be ranked based on Overall Winning Percentage (OWP)
 - Calculation: Total Preliminary Round Matches Won / Total Preliminary Round Matches Played
9. If multiple players/teams are tied with the same OWP then:
 - If 2 teams are tied:
 - Head to head winner from Preliminary Round will get the higher seed
 - If the 2 players/teams did not face each other in the Preliminary Round, move to the next tiebreaker
10. If teams are still tied, then the team with the highest average of sets won PER MATCH will get the higher seed
 - Calculation: (Total Preliminary Sets Won)/(Total Preliminary Matches Played)
 - Example: Match 1: 3-1, Match 2: 1-3, Match 3: 3-1, Total Preliminary Sets Won = 7, Total Preliminary Matches Played = 3;
 - Average Sets Won PER MATCH: 2.333.
11. If teams are still tied, then the team with the lowest average sets lost PER MATCH will get the higher seed
 - Calculation: (Total Preliminary Sets Lost)/(Total Preliminary Matches Played)
 - Example: Match 1: 3-1, Match 2: 1-3, Match 3: 3-1, Total Preliminary Sets Lost = 5, Total Preliminary Matches Played = 3;
 - Average Sets Lost PER MATCH: 1.667.
12. If teams are still tied, then the team with the most points scored PER MATCH will get the higher seed. The max points that will be used for the purposes of this calculation will be 11 (for the winner) or 9 (for the loser)
 - Calculation: (Total Points Scored in all Matches)/(Total Preliminary Matches Played)
 - Example:
 - Match 1: 11-5, 5-11, 11-8, 15-13; Match 2: 18-16, 14-16, 11-8, 9-11, 11-7; Match 3: 11-8, 11-7, 11-7;
 - Total points scored: [(11,5,11,11);(11,9,11,9,11);(11,11,11)] = 122;
 - Total Matches Played = 3;
 - Points scored per match = 40.667
13. If teams are still tied, then the team with the least points allowed PER MATCH will get the higher seed. The max points that will be used for the purposes of this calculation will be 11 (for the winner) or 9 (for the loser)

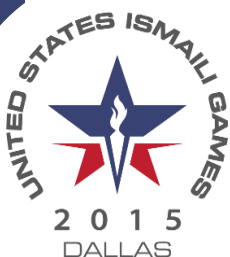


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- Calculation: (Total Points Allowed in all Matches)/(Total Preliminary Matches Played)
- Example:
 - Match 1: 11-5, 5-11, 11-8, 15-13; Match 2: 18-16, 14-16, 11-8, 9-11, 11-7; Match 3: 11-8, 11-7, 11-7;
 - Total points allowed: [(5,11,8,9);(9,11,8,11,7);(8,7,7)] = 101
 - Total Matches Played = 3;
 - Points allowed per match = 33.667

14. If the teams are still tied, then a random draw (i.e. coin toss or electronic formula) will determine the higher seed



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BADMINTON TIEBREAKER

1. Players/teams will be ranked based on Overall Winning Percentage (OWP)
 - Calculation: Total Preliminary Round Matches Wins / Total Preliminary Round Matches Played
2. If multiple players/teams are tied with the same OWP then:
 - If 2 teams are tied:
 - Head to head winner from Preliminary Round will get the higher seed
 - If the 2 players/teams did not face each other in the Preliminary Round, move to the next tiebreaker
3. If teams are still tied, then the team with the highest average of sets won PER MATCH will get the higher seed
 - Calculation: (Total Preliminary Sets Won)/(Total Preliminary Matches Played)
 - Example: Match 1: 2-1, Match 2: 1-2, Match 3: 2-1, Total Preliminary Sets Won = 5, Total Preliminary Matches Played = 3;
 - Average Sets Won PER MATCH: 1.667.
4. If teams are still tied, then the team with the lowest average sets lost PER MATCH will get the higher seed
 - Calculation: (Total Preliminary Sets Lost)/(Total Preliminary Matches Played)
 - Example: Match 1: 2-1; Match 2: 1-2; Match 3: 2-1,
 - Total Preliminary Sets Lost = 4; Total Preliminary Matches Played = 3;

 - Calculation: (Total Points Scored in all Matches)/(Total Preliminary Matches Played)
 - Example:
 - Match 1: 21-10, 21-12; Match 2: 24-22, 25-27, 21-17; Match 3: 21-8, 21-9
 - Total points scored: [(21,21),(21,19,21),(21,21)] = 145; Total Matches Played = 3;
 - Points scored per match = 48.333
6. If teams are still tied, then the team with the least points allowed PER MATCH will get the higher seed. The max points that will be used for the purposes of this calculation will be 21 (for the winner) or 19 (for the loser)
 - Calculation: (Total Points Allowed)/(Total Preliminary Matches Played)
 - Example:



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- Match 1: 21-10, 21-12; Match 2: 24-22, 25-27, 21-17; Match 3: 21-8, 21-9
 - Total points allowed: [(10,12);(19,21,17);(8,9)] = 96; Total Matches Played = 3;
 - Points allowed per match = 32
7. If the teams are still tied, then a random draw (i.e. coin toss or electronic formula) will determine the higher seed

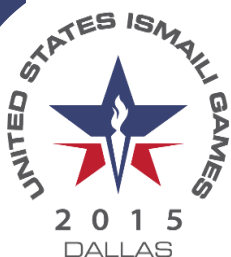


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CHES TIEBREAKER

1. Players with the most accrued points based on the following point system:
 - 1 point for each win
 - ½ point for each draw
 - 0 points for each loss
2. If players are still tied, then a modified Buchholz system will be used to break the ties.
 - When two or more players are tied with the identical number of accrued points from the preliminary round, the sum of all opponents' accrued points from the preliminary round will be calculated to create a "summed score" for each tied player.
 - This summed score will be used as the tiebreak for seeding purposes.
 - The player with the highest summed score will be seeded higher.
3. If the players are still tied, then a random draw (i.e. coin toss or electronic formula) will determine the higher seed

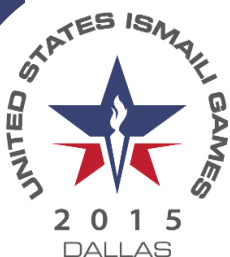


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GOLF TIEBREAKER

1. Each player will play three complete rounds of stroke play golf, with each round being scored individually. No handicaps will be recognized.
2. Each player will use the lowest two (2) scores from the three (3) round to calculate their aggregate score
 - Example:
 - Round 1 – 85 strokes; Round 2 – 87 strokes; Round 3 – 84 strokes
 - Aggregate score: 84 + 85 = 169
3. Players will be ranked via the aggregate starting from lowest aggregate score to highest
4. While determining the top four finishers, if two or more players are tied with the same number of aggregate strokes at the end of all three (3) rounds
 - A Sudden Death playoff will commence starting from the first hole and continuing until the tie is broken
 - After each sudden death hole, the player(s) with the highest number of strokes on that playoff hole will be eliminated.
 - If there is still a tie with two or more players, remaining players will continue onto the next hole until a winner is determined

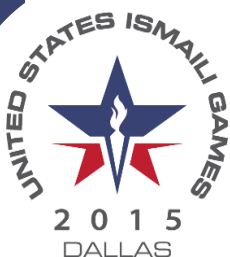


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DANCE TIEBREAKER

1. Teams will be ranked based on Overall Winning Percentage (OWP)
2. If multiple teams are tied with the same OWP then:
 - If 2 teams are tied:
 - Head to head winner from Preliminary Round will get the higher seed
 - If the 2 teams did not face each other in the Preliminary Round, move to 3-team tiebreaker
 - If 3 teams are tied:
 - The team with the highest average point differential will get the higher seed
 - Calculation: $(\text{Total Points Scored} - \text{Total Points Allowed}) / (\text{Total Preliminary Games Played})$
3. If teams are still tied, then the team with the most points scored PER GAME will get the higher seed
 - Calculation:
 - $(\text{Total Points Scored}) / (\text{Total Preliminary Games Played})$
4. If teams are still tied, then the team with the least points allowed PER GAME will get the higher seed
 - Calculation:
 - $(\text{Total Points Allowed}) / (\text{Total Preliminary Games Played})$
5. If the teams are still tied, then a random draw (i.e. coin toss or electronic formula) will determine the higher seed



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
